Strategy Overview

This Internal Quality Assurance (IQA) strategy is what Training Providers must follow to ensure they are complying with iPET Network's Training Provider approval. In addition to this document Training Providers must also familiarise themselves with the *Quality Assurance Requirements* policy.

All iPET Network Training Providers must ensure a robust system of internal quality assurance is operated to ensure a high standard of programme delivery for candidates including its Training Provider Branches, in accordance with iPET Network requirements.

Procedures are in place to provide a description of the Internal Quality Assurance processes accessible to all staff, Training Providers and Training Provider Branches. All Training Providers, including Internal Quality Assurers must have an awareness of all policies.

The IQA strategy states the Training Provider's approach to all aspects of internal quality assurance and includes:

- Co-ordination, planning, quality assurance and record keeping
- This Internal Quality Assurance Strategy will be reviewed and updated as necessary
- Internal Quality Assurers (IQAs) will give verbal and documented feedback to Tutors on all sampled
 assessments and actions. Evidence sampling and observation of assessments will take place as detailed
 in the strategy.
- IQAs must use the Risk Rating to establish the required 'amount' of quality assurance please refer to the relevant Qualification Handbook
- The Training Provider will ensure that all IQAs, Tutors and Training Provider Branches are kept up to
 date with changes to qualifications, delivery documentation and course materials and these are
 implemented in accordance with iPET Network's timescales.
- If the occasion arises, IQAs will help to resolve any disputes and appeals in accordance with iPET Network's Appeals Procedure.

Types of sampling

Formative sampling

Formative sampling takes place periodically during delivery. Formal assessments may not have been fully completed or a unit may have been completed. This type of sampling ensures any concerns are picked up as early as possible, addressed with the Tutor and action is taken.

Summative sampling

IQA reviewing the quality of the assessment decisions made by the Tutor. The IQA should be able to follow an audit trail, which clearly demonstrates that the Tutor has checked the validity, authenticity, reliability, currency and sufficiency of the assessment activity.

Cohort Sampling

For Qualifications that are 1-4 credits and delivered as a cohort the IQA must sample the applicable percentage according to the highest risk rating of the total cohort including a formal summative assessment for each Candidate sampled. The IQA must sample a minimum of 2 Candidates per cohort.

Portfolio sampling



For Qualifications that are 5 credits or more the IQA must sample the applicable percentage according to the highest risk of all Candidate portfolios and all formal summative assessments for each Candidate sampled.

Assessments

Please refer to the relevant Qualification Handbook and sample formal assessments according to the risk rating.

The assessment must be sampled to ensure they meet the following requirements:

- Evidence / documentation used
- Authenticity
- Overall standard of quality
- Feedback from the Tutor to the Candidate
- Briefing and planning

Records and Documentation

All Training Providers must use the iPET Network documentation for internal quality assurance. These records should be kept for a minimum of 3 years for auditing and investigation purposes. Records must be made available for External Quality Assurance audits. All documents are available from iPET Network.

The records must include:

- IQA Sampling Plan
- IQA Sampling Report Form
- Tutor Training Needs Analysis
- IQA Training Needs Analysis
- Tutor Observation Record

IQA sampling plan

Each IQA must demonstrate detailed planning for all Candidates that are registered on an iPET Network qualification. The sampling plan provided by iPET Network allows the IQA to plan the required sampling for each candidate and Tutor.

Qualification Criteria

The Candidate's portfolio must meet 100% of the qualification criteria and be clearly referenced.

Feedback

Feedback must be given on all tasks from the Tutor to the Candidate to encourage, stretch and support learning and progression.

Authentication

All tasks / Assessments must be clear that they have be completed by the Candidate and marked by the Tutor.

IQA Sampling Report Form

This form details the sampling that has been carried out by the IQA. It documents the comments, actions and feedback given to the Tutor and when actions are completed to confirm the quality process is complete.

IQA sampling for E-portfolio

If the Training Providers wishes to use iPET Network's e-portfolio, or an alternative, the above records should still be completed and are integrated within the E-portfolio.
